But, the lessons were really hard, so  One day, I went to a concert and heard a famous guitarist play and I felt I wanted to play the guitar again. I bought a new guitar on my way home, and decided to be a \*professional guitarist. At this time, I taught myself. I listened to many songs, read many textbooks, and also tried to play by ear. However, I found it was difficult to learn the guitar alone, so  That school was very important for me.

Personality :

Paul : Seven to eight hours a day. I practiced hard every day, and I could become a professional guitarist five years later.

Personality : What kind of music do you usually play?

Paul : My band, The Race, is a rock group, so I usually play rock music as a guitarist. However, when I am alone at home, I play all kinds of music, such as pop music, heavy metal, \*folk songs, classical music, dance music, and so on.

Personality : Oh, that's interesting. Finally, could you give some advice to young players?

Paul : OK, please enjoy playing the guitar and

Personality : Thanks, it's good advice.

Paul : My pleasure.

【5】 次の会話は、日本のある高校で、アメリカからの短期留学生のマーク (Mark) がアメリカのスポーツについての発表をしている場面の一部である。この会話を読んで、各問に答えなさい。なお、本文及びグラフのデータ等は架空のものとする。

Mark : Hello, everyone. I am Mark Davis from America. Today, I will talk about the popular sports in America and the sports clubs I belong to at my high school. Now, I have a question. Do you know the four most popular sports in America?

Kenta : Baseball! We can watch American Major League games ( ア ) TV in Japan. I also love playing baseball. I am a member of our high school's baseball club. And... I guess basketball is also one of the four.

Mark : You guessed right! The other two are American football and \*ice hockey. American football, basketball, baseball, and ice hockey are the four most popular sports in America. People in America love watching the games played by \*professional players and get excited when they watch them. American people like not only to watch the games, but also to play the sports. Many boys and girls in America have a dream ( イ ) becoming a star player of one of these four sports. Most high schools in America have their own clubs. In my high school, I play American football and ( A ). The \*figures in the \*graph 1 show the \*percentage of the students who are playing sports at my high school. From the graph, we can see that 25 percent of the boy students chose the same \*combination of sports as me.

Yuko : Do you belong to these two clubs?

Mark : Yes, I do. In America, it is very \*common to play two or three sports in one year. Most American high schools give students chances to belong to different sports clubs in different seasons of the year. ( ウ ) example, my school tells the boys to choose two sports from American football, baseball, basketball, ice hockey, and soccer. The girls are told to choose two sports from \*cheerleading, basketball, soccer, \*softball and ice hockey.

Yuko : I was surprised to hear that. (B)The ideas American people have about playing sports are different from the ideas of Japanese people. In Japan, most of us belong to only one sports club during our three years of high school, and don't want to change our club once we have chosen it. I have never thought about stopping playing basketball and joining another sports club.

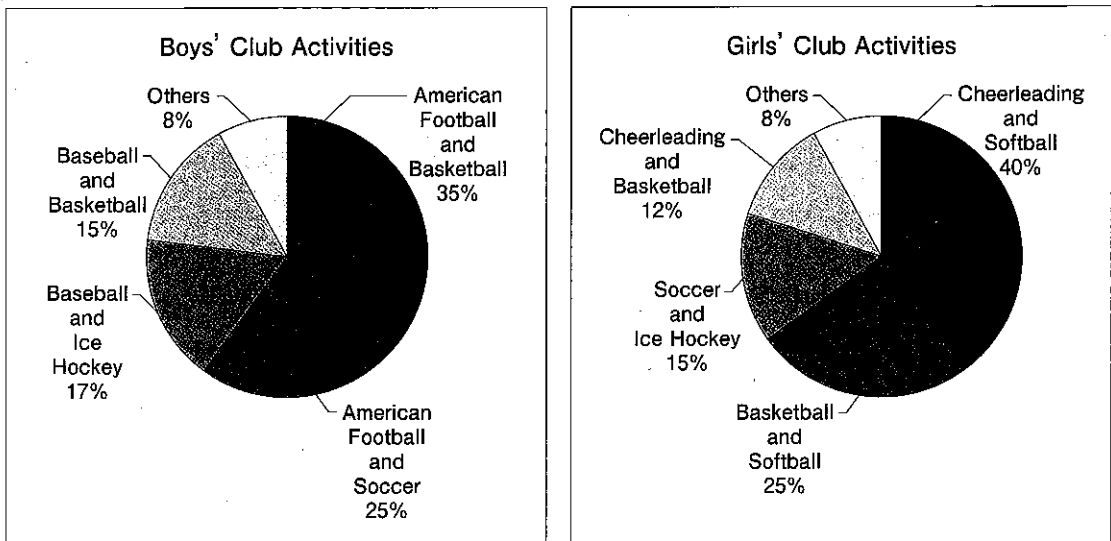


Kenta : That sounds interesting. I want to go to a high school in America and play two sports there.

Mark : If you want to do so, you have to study hard. If you have a bad \*grade for study, the school will tell you to stop your club activities. Studying hard is as important as enjoying sports.
