- 【5】 次の会話は、ケン (Ken) とアヤ (Aya) が、オーストラリアからの短期留学生のシェリー (Sherry) を、市内の有名な観光地に連れていくことを話している場面の一部です。この会話を読んで、各問いに答えなさい。なお、本文及び観光地名、表の数値等は架空のものとする。

Ken : Sherry, we want to show you around some tourist spots in our city this weekend. Here are four spots I *recommend. Now, we want you to choose one of the four spots to visit this weekend from the list in Chart 1. The list in Chart 1 shows each spot's name and *admission fee, and how to access to it.

Chart 1

Name of the spot	Admission fee	How to access
American Hills	(A)	30 minutes by train
Ozeki Memorial Hall	¥300	20 minutes' walk
Kamega-jo Castle	¥450	20 minutes by bus
Midoriyama Park	¥0	15 minutes' walk

Sherry : Thank you, Ken and Aya! I have wanted to know more about your city.
But I will be happy if it does not take much money and time to go there.

Aya : Then, I recommend Midoriyama Park! It's the nearest spot! It takes only 15 minutes to walk there, and we don't need to pay admission fees. There are many kinds of beautiful flowers in the park. Most of them are seen only in Japan. Many tourists come to the park and enjoy its *scenery.

Sherry : It sounds great! But I don't like busy places very much... I mean if there are too many tourists in the park...

Aya : You are right, Sherry. There are so many tourists in Midoriyama Park about this time of the year. You don't want to visit there, do you? Let's see another spot.

Ken : How about American Hills? We can see the culture of America and have a chance to use the language they speak there. All the *staff speak only English and we have to use English in American Hills.

Aya : It's true that to visit American Hills will give us Japanese students a good English-speaking lesson, but what about you, Sherry?

Sherry : You are right, Aya. I will be glad if the spot helps me to speak Japanese...

I want to visit places which will give me a chance to know Japan better.

American Hills' admission fee is higher than the other spots, too.

Ken : OK. Let's see another spot. Ozeki Memorial Hall is a museum about Yuji Ozeki, a great music *composer born in this city. He wrote many *pieces of popular songs, and a TV drama about his life was also made. In the hall, we can see many *music scores he wrote, photos showing his life, and the *organ he used when he *composed music.

Aya : The last one is Kamega-jo Castle. It is one of the famous castles built in the *Edo period. In the castle, we can see the way people lived two hundred years ago in Japan. We can also see the *weapons and *armor *samurai warriors used in the past. It will be an exciting place to visit if you are interested in Japanese history. So, which of the four spots would you like to visit, Sherry?

Sherry : I will choose (B) because I want to know more about the music and songs which are popular among Japanese people. The admission fee is not free, but it's cheaper than two of the other spots. I can't wait for this weekend!
