Bill : I'll be free next Saturday. How about you?

Bill : Oh, I see. When I first met you, you said that you were a member of the volleyball club, right? All right, are you free next Sunday?

Emi : Yes, that day will be OK with me.

Bill : OK. Let's decide where to meet. How about your house?

Emi : Sure.

Emi : No, it isn't. It's near Kaede Station.

Bill : OK. What time should I come to your house? Can I come in the morning?

Emi :  (7)

Bill : All right. Then how about one in the afternoon?

Emi : OK! Please come to my house then.

Bill : Thank you. I'm looking forward to visiting the shop!

- ① Your house is near the City Library, right?
- ② I'd love to go there!
- ③ Everything has been going very well.
- ④ By the way, did you know that a new ice cream shop opened near our school?
- ⑤ Well, I have a piano class in the morning.
- ⑥ I'll be free on that day.
- ⑦ Sorry, I have to practice volleyball at school on that day.
- ⑧ How about visiting it together?
- ⑨ The morning is OK with me.

- 【5】 次の文は、日本の高校生のヒデキ(Hideki)とユイ(Yui)が、イギリスからの留学生ジェーン(Jane)とフランスからの留学生ポール(Paul)と一緒に、ユイの家で話をしている場面の一部である。四人の会話を読んで、(1)～(5)の問いに答えなさい。なお、グラフのデータは架空のものとする。

Hideki : Thank you for inviting us to your house, Yui. Oh, you have a lot of books!  
Do you like reading books?

Yui : Yes, I do. I've loved reading them since I was ten.

Jane : Really? I often read science books. What kind of books do you read?

Yui : I read \*novels. Recently I've been interested in \*Albert Camus, and yesterday, when I went to a bookstore near the school with my father, I bought one of his famous novels, \**L'Étranger*.

Paul : *L'Étranger*? I like that novel, too!

Yui : Really? I read it in Japanese, but someday I would like to read it in \*French. Can you teach me French, Paul?

Paul : *Oui, bien sûr!*

Yui : What? I couldn't understand. What do you mean?

Paul : It means "Yes, of course!" in French.

Yui : Thank you!

Hideki : You're from France, right? I'm interested in French, too. I also want to learn it, so can you teach me French someday?

Paul : Sure, Hideki! By the way, I've found an interesting graph on the Internet.

Jane : Really? What is it about?

Paul : It is a graph about when people read books. It is the result of some research done by a Japanese company. Look.

Hideki : Oh, it's interesting. Most people say they read books on weekends. Do you read books on weekends, Jane?

Jane : Yes, I do. It's the best time for me to read a lot of books. Do you read books on weekends, too, Hideki?

Hideki : No, I don't. Well, I'm a member of the tennis club at school. I like it very much. I have to practice tennis hard not only after school but also on weekends, ( ア ) I don't have time to read books then. I usually read books before going to bed. This graph shows that this way of reading books is a little more popular with people than reading books when they are free. How about you, Yui?

Yui : Well, I usually read them when I go to school. I like to do so. When I go to school, I can \*concentrate on reading.

Jane : Do you go to school by train?

Yui : No, by bus. It takes about one hour to go to school, so I always have two or three books in my school bag. When I'm on the bus, I read them. I can sit down on the bus, so it's really \*comfortable!

Jane : Oh, I see. According to the graph, the number of people who read books like you is a little larger than that of people who read them in the early morning.

Paul : Really? I usually get up at five every day, so I like to read books after getting up. Getting up early makes me feel good.

Hideki : I agree with you, Paul. I usually get up at five, too, but I don't do anything special after getting up. So, I will try reading books at around that time! What book do you \*recommend, Yui?

Yui : Well, you like tennis, right? How about a book about famous tennis players?

Hideki : That's a good idea!

Jane : I agree with you, Yui. Reading books about your favorite things will be fun for you.

Paul : I think so, too.


